

THE LONELY DANDELION

4 couple longways set, 1s and 3s improper.

Tune: "The Lonely Dandelion" (waltz) by Richard Stapledon.

A1	<p>1s step Right, acknowledging partner, cross over left shoulder and move down the outside to 2nd place (2s move up) (4 bars);</p> <p>1s step Left, acknowledging partner, cross over right shoulder and move down the outside to 3rd place (3s move up) (4 bars).</p>
A2	<p>4s step Right, acknowledging partner, cross over left shoulder and move up the outside to 3rd place (1s move down) (4 bars);</p> <p>4s step Left, acknowledging partner, cross over right shoulder and move up the outside to 2nd place (3s move down) (4 bars).</p> <p><i>Order now 2431, 1s and 3s improper</i></p>
B1	<p>In 4s at each end, ½ RH Star (2 bars), then middle 4 ½ LH Star <i>while</i> ends ½ LH turn (2 bars);</p> <p>In 4s at ends, ½ RH Star (2 bars), all turn single out of the star away from your partner (clover-leaf) (2 bars).</p>
B2	<p>In 4s poussette to change places, men pushing first (4 bars);</p> <p>All set R & L to partner and turn single Right (4 bars).</p>

Progression is 4, 1, 2, 3 with new 1st and 3rd couples improper.

Repeat 3 more times to get back home.

Note: The stepping (NOT setting) in A1 and A2 is man up lady down for the 1s and man down lady up for the 4s.
